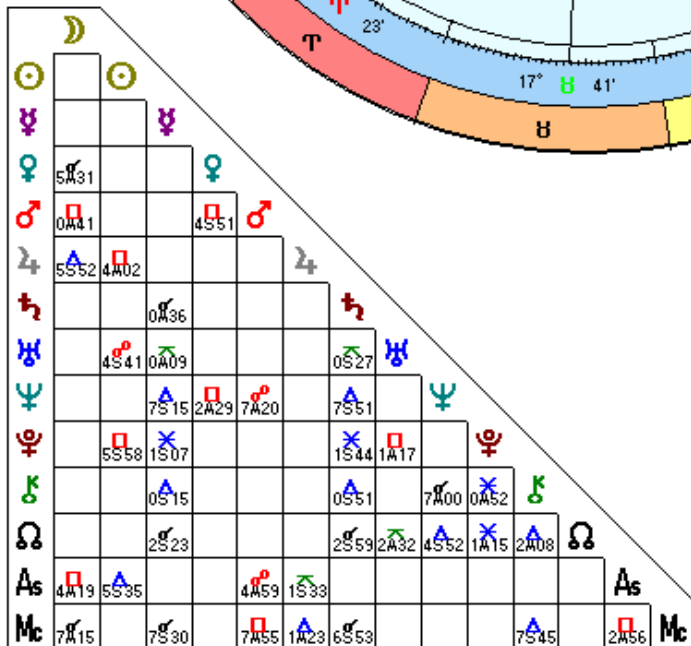
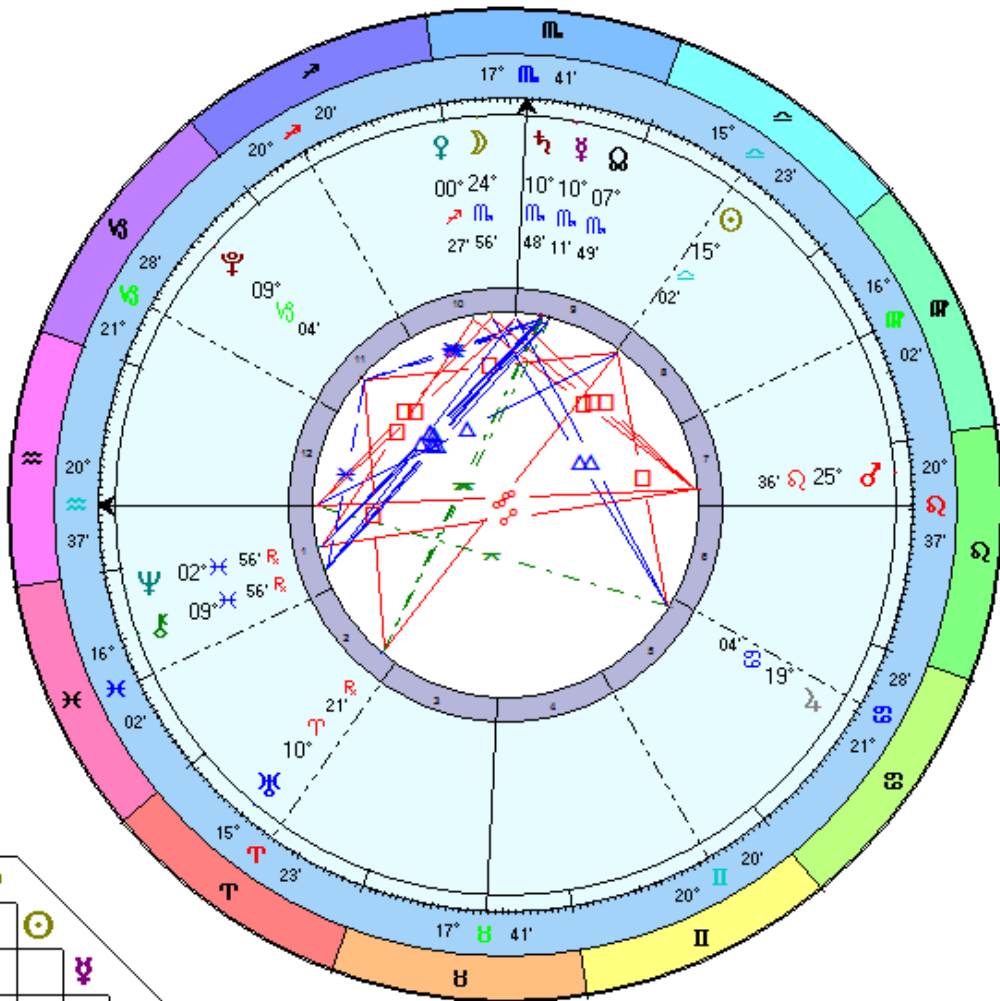

As a result it can give you insights on how to best nurture Sophia as a baby and maturing young adult. Swimming, building sandcastles by the ocean, fishing, canoeing, and snorkelling are just a few options that could prove beneficial. He could also create special times with Sophia by retreating from the world and relaxing together in a secluded environment. Young Sophia may also benefit from having one or more special photographs of her father in her room.

Whatever the circumstances it is important that some gentle means can be found to provide young Sophia with a positive male influence. Otherwise she may develop traits such as bed-wetting, minor illnesses and sulking as ways to express her lack of connection to positive male role models.
